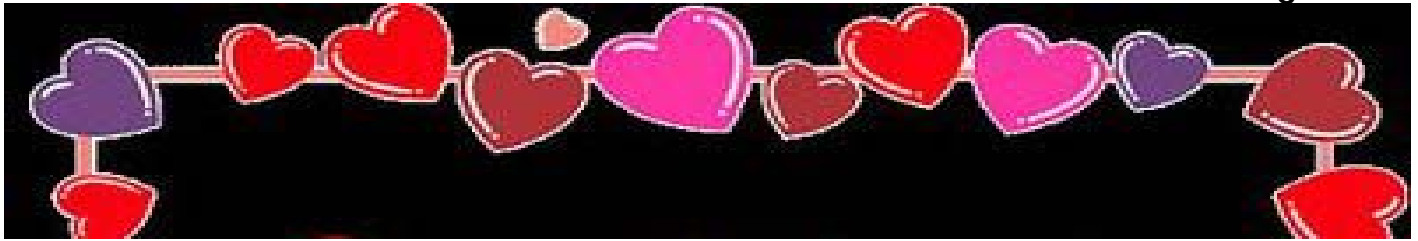

Even a minor collision can throw your dog around inside the car, or even worse, out of the car, and he/she could sustain great injury.

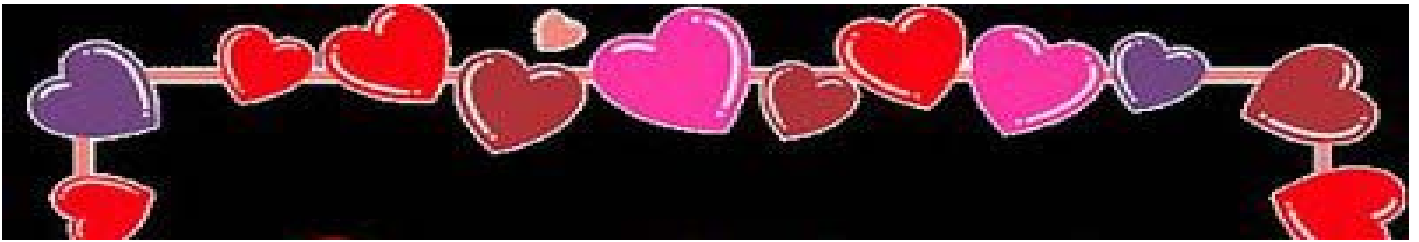
If you are injured, you will not be able to help your dog, who may become frightened & run away into traffic, or he may become frightened and bite someone who is trying to help him.

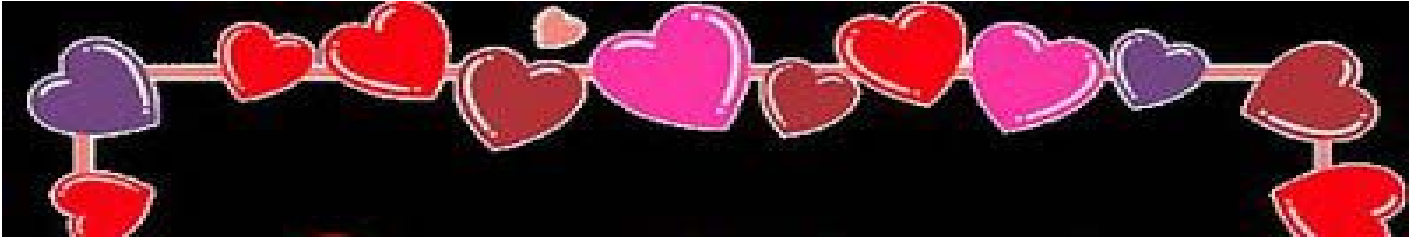

DOES YOUR DOG HAVE A TUMOR???? IP6 May Be The Answer: READ THIS TRUE STORY!*

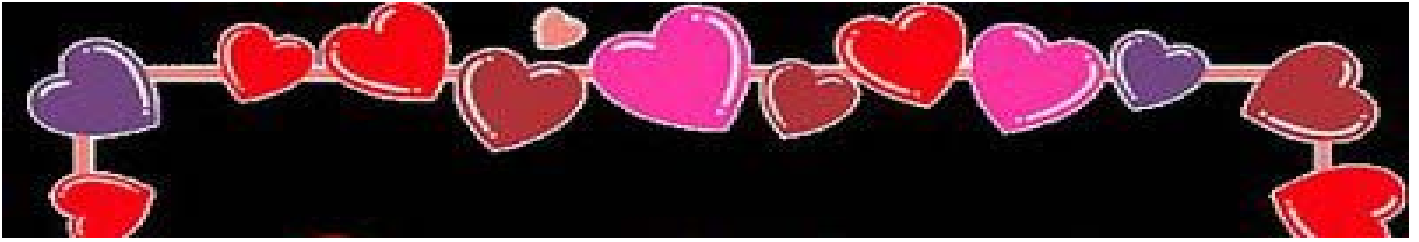
